















CAN/CSA-Z614 STANDARD AND ASTM F1487

Brought into effect several years ago, the Canadian and American standards on playgrounds contain sections and benchmarks on accessibility for children with reduced mobility. This primarily involves Appendix H of the CAN/CSA-Z614 standard and the Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines (ADAAG).
